Human identity exists at the intersection of the ancient cycles of air, water and soil. In spite of the pervasive illusion of separation, in reality no separation is possible between nature and ourselves. Arne Naess, Emeritus Professor of Philosophy at Oslo University, suggested that what is needed are community therapies "healing our relations to the widest community, that of all living beings". By acknowledging our interconnectedness we invite the spontaneous healing of the psyche. In this workshop we participate in a series of processes and rituals informed by those used by indigenous peoples throughout time. Using personal sharing, experiential deep ecology and a **Council of All Beings**, we will dissolve the separation between person and planet. Vision and empowerment arise naturally from realigning ourselves with the living Earth. On Saturday evening we will view Brian Swimme's "Journey of the Universe" followed by a Cosmic Walk ceremony.
